When we moved to Prague with our kids last summer, we initially tried to manage with just public transport and occasional car rentals for day trips. After three months of logistical headaches, especially with the children's activities, we switched to a long term auto rental and it completely transformed our experience. Having a dedicated vehicle made grocery shopping, weekend adventures, and school drop-offs infinitely easier. We could spontaneously decide to visit Bohemian Switzerland or drive to Dresden without planning days in advance. The monthly rate was reasonable compared to multiple weekend rentals, and we didn't have the hassle of car ownership like Czech insurance, winter tire changes, or depreciation worries. If you'll be in Prague for a full year with kids, I'd definitely recommend exploring the long term auto rental option - it gives you the perfect balance of convenience and flexibility
