I've found that the "rhythm" of a game—the way the music swells during a big win or the subtle pause before a scatter lands—is what truly prevents the experience from feeling like a repetitive task. Pacing is the invisible hand that keeps the adrenaline flowing, and when a studio gets the atmosphere just right, you stop focusing on the numbers and start enjoying the "vibe" of the game itself.
